

Union Church – Return to In-Person Worship Q & A

What services will you hold on Sunday?

We will be holding the 8:45, 9:45 and 11.15 services this Sunday. There will **NOT** be a 5:15PM service.

Will there be a Filipino Service?

Yes, the Filipino service will start at 3pm

Are there any restrictions in place?

Yes, we will need everyone to have their temperature taken (this is done in the building lobby, by ST management), everyone will need to wear masks, no food or drink can be provided, we will ask everyone to sign a health declaration and we will provide hand sanitiser on arrival for everyone. Additionally, we are only allowed 50% of our normal capacity.

50% of our normal capacity. How many is that?

We can normally have 200 people on the 18F, so that means only 100 people for the time being. Please note though that this includes the staff, AV team and musicians/choir, so that only leaves about 75 spaces. **Please come early** to avoid disappointment.

What happens if the sanctuary is full?

We will ask people if they would like to go to the Hotel Indigo where we will be streaming the service live. We have space there for a further 23 people.

Can I bring my children?

Absolutely yes! Your children are welcome to come with you, either into the sanctuary, or they can join Miss Jacklien for a Veggie Tales movie at the 9.45 or 11.15 services.

Can I bring my baby?

Again, absolutely. The creche will be open at the 9.45 and 11.15 services.

What precautions are you taking?

In addition to the precautions mentioned earlier, to maintain social distancing we will place the chairs 1m apart and will be installing a plexiglass screen between the stage and the congregation. We also have air purifiers in place and will be disinfecting the sanctuary after each service. Please help us by not moving the chairs and by leaving promptly after the service ends.

Will I need to sign a Health Declaration?

Yes, we will need everyone to sign this, either in advance, or on the day. One person can do this for the entire family.

How can I help?

Please bear with us as we try to get everyone into the sanctuary safely. There may be delays at the door, so **please try to come early**.
